✓ to express an action that was happening and continuing at a definite time in the past.

Ex: They were having dinner at 7 p.m. yesterday.

 \checkmark to express an action that was happening in the past then another action happened and interrupted it.

Ex: When he came, they were watching television.

 \checkmark to express two actions happening at the same time in the past.

Ex: Mary was reading books while Peter was playing badminton
