I. VOCABULARY

1. affect (v) [ə'fekt] : ảnh hưởng
2. appreciate (v) [ə'pri:ʃieɪt] : trân trọng
3. embrace (v) [ɪm'breɪs] : ôm chặt
Ex: - They **embraced** and promised to keep in touch.
 - She **embraced** her son warmly.
4. experience (n) [ɪks'pɪəriəns] : trải nghiệm, kinh nghiệm
5. escape (v) [ɪ'skeɪp] : trốn thoát, thoát khỏi
Ex: - Two prisoners have **escaped**.
 - A lion has **escaped from its cage**.
6. gas stove (n) [gæs stəʊv] : bếp ga
7. memorable (a) ['memərəbl] : đáng nhớ, không quên được
 = *unforgettable* (adj.) /ʌnfə'getəbl/

8. protect (v) [prə'tekt] (**from**) : bảo vệ
Ex: - Are we doing enough to **protect** the environment?
 - Scientists state that it is important to **protect** your skin **from** the harmful effects of the sun.
9. realise (v) ['riəlaɪz] : nhận ra
10. scream (v) [skri:m] : la hét
11. terrified (a) ['terɪfaɪd] (**of**) : cảm thấy khiếp sợ, kinh hãi
Ex: - I'm **terrified of** the dark.
 - I was absolutely **terrified** when I heard the door opening.
12. to **grow up** [grəʊp] : lớn lên, trưởng thành
Ex: - She **grew up** on a Sapa farm.
 - He's **grown up** quickly since going to high school.
13. to **be on fire** = burning : bị cháy
Ex: - The building is **on fire**!
14. to **burn down** (sth) to **destroy** something with **fire**, or to be **destroyed** in this way : *thiêu hủy, thiêu trụi*
Ex: - They weren't **injured**, but **their house burned down**.
 - He **tried to burn down** the house by setting **fire** to a **pile of papers**.
