I. VOCABULARY

1. affect (v) [ə'fekt] : *anh hưởng*

2. appreciate (v) [ə'pri:ʃieit] : *trân trọng*

3. embrace (v) [im'breis] : ôm chặt

Ex: - They **embraced** and promised to keep in touch.

- She **embraced** her son warmly.

4. experience (n) [iks'piəriəns] : trải nghiệm, kinh nghiệm

5. escape (v) [1'skeɪp] : trốn thoát, thoát khỏi

Ex: - Two <u>prisoners</u> have **escaped.**

A <u>lion</u> has **escaped** from <u>its</u> <u>cage</u>.

6. gas stove (n) [gæs stəʊv] : bếp ga

7. memorable (a) ['memərəbl] : đáng nhớ, không quên được

= unforgettable (adj.) /\nfə'getəbl/

8. protect (v) [prəˈtekt] (*from*) : bảo vệ

Ex: - Are we doing enough to **protect** the environment?

- Scientists state that it is important to **protect** your skin **from** the harmful effects of the sun.

9. realise (v) ['riəlaiz] : nhận ra

10. scream (v) [skri:m] : la hét

11. terrified (a) ['terifaid] (of) : câm thấy khiếp sợ, kinh hãi

Ex: - I'm **terrified of** the <u>dark</u>.

- I was absolutely **terrified** when I heard the door opening.

12. to **grow up** [grou] : lớn lên, trưởng thành

Ex: - She **grew up** on a Sapa farm.

- He's **grown up** quickly since going to high school.

13. to **be on fire** = burning : *bi cháy*

 \underline{Ex} : - The **building** is **on fire**!

14. to **burn down** (sth) to **destroy** something with **fire**, or to be **destroyed** in this way : *thiêu hủy, thiêu trui*

Ex: - They weren't **injured**, but **their house burned down**.

- He **tried** to **burn down** the house by setting **fire** to a **pile** of **papers**.
