## GRAMMAR : REPORTED SPEECH (Caâu töôøng thuaät)

## 1/ Reporting Statements (Töôøng thuaät caâu noùi thoâng thöôøng)

A/ Reported speech (hoaëc Indirect speech) laø caâu noùi duøng ñeå töôøng thuaät laïi ñieàu maø moät ngöôøi naøo ñoù ñaõ noùi tröôùc ñoù. Trong tieáng Anh, khi vieát laïi nguyeân vaên moät caâu noùi cuûa ngöôøi naøo, ngöôøi ta thöôøng vieát (hoaëc in) caâu noùi aáy giöõa hai ngoaëc keùp. Haõy so saùnh caâu tröïc tieáp (Indirect speech) vaø caâu töôøng thuaät (Reported speech) sau ñaây:

Direct: "I'm writing a letter to my parents," Pam said.

Reported: Pam said (that) she was writing a letter to her parents.

B/ Thoâng thöôøng, khi ñoåi moät caâu noùi tröïc tieáp sang caâu töôøng thuaät, chuùng ta phaûi laøm moät soá thay ñoåi nhö sau:

1/ Baét ñaàu caâu töôøng thuaät baèng:

(He) said that ..., hoaëc (He) told me that ...

CHUÙ YÙ : Chuùng ta khoâng duøng tuùc töø (object) sau "said"; nhöng sau "told" phaûi coù tuùc töø (object):

Right: (He) said that ... / (He) said to me that ...

(He) told me that ...

Wrong: (He) said me that ... / (He) told that ...

2/ Phaûi boû daáu ngoaëc keùp khi töôøng thuaät.

3/ Caùc ñaii töø thöôøng phaûi thay ñoåi cho phuø hôip nhö sau:

## 4/ Thay ñoåi moät soá caùch noùi thôøi gian vaø nôi choán:

today	that day
tonight	that night
now	then
tomorrow	the next day / the following day
yesterday	the day before / the previous day
next (week)	the next (week) / the following (week)
last (week)	the (week) before / the previous week
(three days) ago	(three days) before

this / these	that / those
here	there

5/ Thay ñoåi thì töø caâu tröïc tieáp sang caâu töôøng thuaät nhö sau:

Direct	Reported
Present simple	Past simple
"I do it," he said.	He said he did it.
Past simple	Past perfect
"I did it," he said.	He said he had done it.
Present perfect	Past perfect
"I have done it," he said.	He said he had done it.
Present progressive	Past progressive
"I am doing it," he said.	He said he was doing it.
Past progressive	Past perfect progressive
"I was doing it," he said.	He said he had been doing it.
Present perfect progressive	Past perfect progressive
"I have been doing it," he said.	He said he had been doing it.
Modals: will/can/may	Past modals:
"I will/can/may do it," he said.	would/could/might
	He said he would/could/might do
	it.

C/ Nhööng trööøng hôïp khoâng caàn thay ñoåi thì khi tööøng thuaät:

1/ "must" coù theå giöõ nguyeân hoaëc ñoåi thaønh "had to". Ví duï:

Direct: "I must finish this report by Monday," Jill said.

Reported: Jill said that she must finish that report by Monday.

Or: Jill said that she had to finish that report by Monday.

2/ "should" vaø "ought to" coù theå giöõ nguyeân hoaëc töôøng thuaät baèng caùch duøng ñoäng töø "advise sb (not) to do sth". Ví duï:

Direct: "You should practice your English every day," said Miss Hoa.

Reported: Miss Hoa said that I should practice my English every day.

Or: Miss Hoa advised me to practice my English every day.

Direct: "You oughtn't to lie in the sun for long hours, Nam," said Ba.

Reported: Ba said that Nam oughtn't to lie in the sun for long hours.

Or: Ba advised Nam not to lie in the sun for long hours.

3/ Moät soá Modals khaùc nhöù "needn't do", "would do", "could do", vaø "might do" thöôøng ñöôïc giöõ nguyeân khi töôøng thuaät. Ví duï:

Direct: "You needn't do it if you don't want," she said.

Reported: She said that I needn't do it if I didn't want.

Direct: "It would be nice if I could see you again, Pam," Mike said.

Reported: Mike said it would be nice if he could see Pam again.

Direct: "It might be too dangerous for us to go now," said Jack.

Reported: Jack said it might be too dangerous for them to go then.

4/ Khi töôøng thuaät caâu ñieàu kieän (Conditional sentences), ta thay ñoåi thì vôùi caâu ñieàu kieän loaïi 1. Ñoái vôùi caâu ñieàu kieän loaïi 2, coù theå thay ñoåi thì hoaëc vaãn giöo nguyeân. Dó nhieân chuùng ta khoâng thay ñoåi thì vôùi loaïi 3. Ví duï:

Direct: "If I hear anything new, I'll let you know," Paul said.

Reported: Paul said that if he heard anything new he would let me know.

Direct: "If I knew her number, I would tell you," Peter said.

Reported: Peter said if he knew her number, he would tell me.

Or: Peter said if he had known her number, he would have told me.

## 2/ Reporting questions (Töôøng thuaät caâu hoûi)

Khi töôøng thuaät caâu hoûi, ta caàn phaân bieät hai loaïi caâu hoûi tröïc tieáp laø: 'Whquestions' (Caâu hoûi baét ñaàu baèng töø-ñeå-hoûi) vaø 'Yes-No questions' (Caâu hoûi baét ñaàu baèng ñoäng töø ñeå coù caâu traû lôøi "Yes' hoaëc 'No'). Sau ñaây laø moät soá ñieåm caàn löu yù khi töôøng thuaät caû hai loaïi caâu hoûi:

- 1/ Chuùng ta thöôøng töôøng thuaät caâu hoûi baèng caùc caùch noùi sau:
  - (He) asked (me) ...
  - (He) wondered ...
  - (He) wanted to know ...
- 2/ Khoâng duøng theå ñaûo-ñoäng-töø khi töôøng thuaät caâu hoûi. Nghóa laø khoâng ñaët ñoäng töø (hoaëc trôï ñoäng töø) tröôùc chuû töø trong caâu töôøng thuaät.
- 3/ Boû daáu chaám hoûi vaø daáu ngoaëc keùp khi töôøng thuaät caâu hoûi.
- 4/ Thay ñoåi thì cuûa ñoäng töø, caùch noùi thôøi gian, nôi choán, vaø ñaïi töø cho phuø hôïp nhö khi töôøng thuaät caâu noùi thoâng thöôøng.
- 5/ Ñoái vôùi caâu hoûi 'Wh-questions', ta laëp laïi caùc töø ñeå hoûi nhö : what, where, when, who, which, how, how much, how many, how long, .... Chuù yù: chuùng ta khoâng duøng chöố 'that' tröôùc caùc töø ñeå hoûi.
- 6/ Ñoái vôùi caâu hoûi 'Yes-No questions', ta coù theå môû ñaàu caâu hoûi töôøng thuaät baèng caùch duøng 'if' hoaëc 'whether' (xem baûng so saùnh hai loaïi caâu hoûi töôøng thuaät beân döôùi). Chuù yù: chuùng ta khoâng duøng chöõ 'that' tröôùc 'if' hoaëc 'whether'.

So saùnh caùch töôøng thuaät caâu hoûi 'Wh-questions' vaø 'Yes-No questions':
